Hello Dog Owners,

While we understand your dog is like a family member, we ask that you read and comply with the guidelines below to ensure that all of our guests have a safe and pleasant stay.

- Please be aware that all dogs must be on a leash at all times while outside on RDC property.
- Dog owners are responsible for picking up after their dogs. Please deposit baggies in one of the several outside containers located throughout Camp. Extra baggies are available by request.
- Dogs left unattended in a cottage must be in a crate or pet carrier.
- While RDC staff are servicing the cottage, dogs must be in a crate/carrier or taken outside.
 There is no extra fee for dogs, but owners will be responsible for any damages caused by their dog.
- All RDC cottages are dog friendly accommodations. However, our lodges and dining facilities are not.
- Dog owners will keep their dogs off of all furniture including beds, chairs and couches. We know
 that you will agree that dogs do not belong on our beds and furniture. While our housekeeping
 staff is very thorough, microscopic dog dander can cause irritation to other guests with allergies.
- Proper medical certification, specifying that all vaccinations are up to date, must be available upon request.
- Please leave easily stressed and noisy dogs at home.
- There is a limit of two dogs per cottage.
